

WMAA PAM KEATING AWARD 2011



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TERMS OF REFERENCE & NOMINATION FORM

The Waste Management Association of Australia (WMAA) Pam Keating Award recognises the contribution of the late Pam Keating (1954-2009) across a number of sectors in the environment industry in Victoria. Among Pam's many achievements, key contributions included her roles as:

- President and Executive Committee Member of the Waste Management Association of Australia (Victoria Branch)
- Chairman of Keep Australia Beautiful Victoria
- Director of Sustainable Learning Australasia Pty Ltd
- Director of Waste Audit & Consultancy Services (Aust) Pty Ltd
- Director of Gippsland Water
- Board Member of Environment Victoria
- Board Member of Metropolitan Waste Management Group
- Board Member of Zero Waste SA
- Board Member of Business Skills Victoria
- Member of EPA's Prescribed Industrial Waste Advisory Committee.

The WMAA Pam Keating Award will be awarded to a woman who has made a significant contribution to the Victorian environment industry in the past 5 years, with a particular focus on the areas reflecting Pam's involvement. The winner will receive an amount of \$1,500 to be used for the purposes of professional development. This may include a course of study, attendance at environmental conferences/seminars or other relevant applications. Evidentiary proof will be required prior to payment of the award to the winner. There is no age limit on nominees, but they must demonstrate that they have at least 2 years experience in the environment industry.

Nominations for the WMAA Pam Keating Award are called every year. A WMAA sub-committee considers all nominations for the Award; the sub-committee may elect not to select a recipient of the Award for a particular year. Lobbying of the members of the sub-committee by nominees or their supporters may result in disqualification. The decision of WMAA (Victoria) will be final and no appeals will be accepted.

The Award is sponsored by Veolia Environmental Services and the trophy is sponsored by Sustainability Victoria.

Applications for the 2011 WMAA Pam Keating Award are open from 1 July 2011 to 31 August 2011.

Nominations for the Award must be submitted on the nomination form and received by 31 August 2011. All queries and completed nomination forms must be sent by email to vic@wmaa.asn.au. The nomination must be supported by a person (female or male) with a demonstrated experience of at least 5 years working in the environment industry. The nominee and their supporter must sign and verify the application to confirm the accuracy of the information supplied.

Nominees must provide a response (up to 100 words) on each of the following criteria:

- development and promotion of sustainability issues
- cooperation and collaboration with industry/stakeholders
- contribution to innovation
- activities that promote professional development in the environment industry
- demonstrated success in sustainability outcomes
- demonstrated leadership qualities around sustainability issues.

Nominees must also provide an outline (up to 500 words) on how they propose to use the award funds for professional development.

The Award will be presented to the winner at the WMAA (Victoria) Christmas dinner in early December (date to be confirmed). The winner will be expected to give a presentation at the awards ceremony in December 2011 and a presentation as a past winner at the awards ceremony in 2012. The winner should also be prepared to participate in media events and announcements from time to time.



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
